

Tobacco Free Campus Policy (Implementation Date 11-16-06)

GOAL:

It is the goal of Decatur County Memorial Hospital to provide the comfort and safety of a tobacco free environment, and to educate patients, visitors, and associates on the adverse effects of tobacco use. Decatur County Memorial Hospital provides a supportive framework to promote and assist in smoking cessation.

POLICY:

Decatur County Memorial Hospital is committed to the promotion of health and prevention of disease. The use of tobacco products has been determined to be a major cause of illness and disease for both the user and non-user in the immediate environment. Therefore, Decatur County Memorial Hospital does not permit the use of any type of tobacco product on the premises and affiliated properties.

Segments Addressed

Employees

- a. Tobacco use is prohibited on hospital grounds, related properties and leased facilities.
- b. Violators shall be subject to disciplinary action.

Physicians

a. Physicians will not write orders for patients to smoke or utilize tobacco products.

Patients

a. Tobacco use by patients is prohibited on hospital grounds, related properties and leased facilities.

Visitors - Vendors

- a. Visitors who wish to utilize tobacco products are to be directed off campus.
- b. Those challenging the policy shall be given a copy thereof.
